

GCSP 25TH Anniversary

Photo Contest Terms & Rules

- **1.** The 25th Anniversary Photo contest is open to anyone.
- 2. All photo submissions must be submitted via <u>WeTransfer</u>. Entries sent in other ways will not be accepted.
- **3.** A picture can only be entered once for each category, that is a maximum of 3 pictures per candidate. Pictures submitted more than once will be removed from the contest.
- Confidentiality applies in compliance with the GDPR prevailing within the EU (see our <u>Privacy Policy</u>). All questions or inquiries may be addressed to privacy@gcsp.ch.
- **5.** The person submitting photos certifies that he/she is the author/owner and ensures that he/she has the authorisation to reproduce the likehood of any person present on his/her photo.
- 6. Pictures can be submitted whether or not they have been published.
- 7. Pictures must meet the following specifications:
 - Upload images with the original pixel size (unless cropped). Do not scale and do not change the resolution.
 - Must be uploaded in JPEG format with high quality compression. Winning images may be used for high quality reproduction.
- 8. Pictures must be identified and show" the following details:
 - i name of the photographer
 - date of origin (month, year)
 - the location
 - a title
 - b choice of category

(*these details can be included in the metadata of the pictures but must not be visible on the picture itself).



- **9.** Pictures taken at restricted events (that is, events where only photographers commissioned by those organising the event, for example governments, political parties or corporations have access), are not accepted.
- **10.** Only single exposure and single frame pictures will be accepted. The following are not accepted:
 - Multiple exposures, polyptychs (diptychs, triptychs, and so forth)
 - Stitched panoramas, either produced in-camera or with image editing software
- **11.** The content of a picture must not be altered by adding, rearranging, reversing, distorting or removing people and/or objects from within the frame.
- **12.** The jury determines which changes are significant and count as manipulation.
- **13.** The deadline for registration and submitting photographs to the contest is set on Sunday 15 November 2020, 24:00, CET (Geneva Time).
- **14.** Copyright holders retain copyright of their work. For awarded pictures, copyright holders grant the GCSP unlimited non-exclusive use of high-resolution pictures for activities in all media, including social media, online and print, in relation to the contest, the exhibition, the yearbook, the public archive, and all promotional and educational activities and without any remuneration being due.
- **15.** The copyright holders represent and warrant that submission of the pictures does not breach any law, and further that no third party can hold any claims or any objections regarding the rights granted to the GCSP.
- **16.** The <u>consent form</u> provided upon registration needs to be signed and returned as an attachment with the photo submitted to the GCSP.
- **17.** The conditions set out in the Entry Rules are binding, and the GCSP reserves the right to refuse or exclude any entry at its own discretion.
