The course provides you with a comprehensive and analytical overview of the impact of transformative technologies across several domains, including their ethical and security implications. In addition the course will further your understanding of how transformative technologies will impact the future of warfare.

The principal course objectives are:

- Define and understand the impact of transformative technologies
- Analyse the effects of these through the prism of moral philosophy and global security
- Identify key future risks and debates surrounding advances in these technologies

In the last few years, the field of transformative technologies has expanded at a dizzying rate. While scientific advances can offer untold benefits to humanity, they also pose a myriad of thorny questions about equality, ethics, security – and our very existence.

This course examines the latest developments in transformative technologies, including but not limited to Artificial Intelligence (AI), autonomous weapons, Big Data, and virtual reality. It examines the short- and long-term ramifications of these technologies in today's interconnected world.

## COURSE FOCUS:

The course is interactive and employs different teaching methodologies including group work, lectures and participant-led discussions. It rests on the three pillars that characterise the GCSP's unique learning experience: the latest thinking and research from high-level academia, the experience of senior practitioners, and the input of professional participants. It is an exceptionally stimulating environment, enabling you and your peers to engage in a challenging topic and explore the latest developments in a cutting-edge domain.
