 - To the best of your knowledge, how has your nominee concretely impacted global peace and security?
 - To the best of your knowledge, how has your nominee changed the field/environment you work in?
 - To the best of your knowledge, how has your nominee demonstrated innovation and creativity in advancing peace and security?

- COLLABORATION:



 To the best of your knowledge, how has your nominee advanced peace and security across different domains or divides?
To the best of your knowledge, how has your nominee adopted the idea that "only together can we create a safer world"?

- INFLUENCE

• To the best of your knowledge, how has your nominee generated awareness, support or mobilisation of people to get involved in their work? (i.e. activism, impactful research, perseverance (conflict/mediation), dedicated and long-term influence on highly complex issues such as small changes in international agreements)

- LEADERSHIP:

- To the best of your knowledge, how has your nominee helped lead change?
- What is it about your nominee and their leadership that led you to nominate them?
- What kind of role model are they to you?
- To the best of your knowledge, how has your nominee made a difference, adapted change or spoken truth to power?
