

Participants criteria

The main target group is composed of engaged and active young leaders and changemakers who are starting their careers or holding positions that can impact others.

The selection of participants for this course will be made by GCSP following the eligibility criteria as follows.

This project is partly funded by Movetia and GCSP with the support of Initiatives of Change.

Given its uniqueness, GCSP is opening a few extra spots to welcome more participants who are able to contribute the whole fee to participate in the programme.

All participants selected for this course must be:

1

Youth (18-35 years old) actively involved in development activities, ideally involved in peace or development processes or education.

2

Able to attend the full duration of the training course and fully able to communicate and work in English language

3

Committed to disseminating the results and multiplying the impact of the project by actively working with peers in their local communities





Why #LIMPACTYOUth?



"There are many things you can do alone, the important ones need other people to get involved"

Many development initiatives all around don't achieve full impact or fail due to missing key elements that could have been easily solved. Some of those could be, for example: engaging the right people at the right level, knowing ourselves, following a common direction, communicating for impact, or, understanding the context we work in and our own biases.

Combining leadership, youth, and impact initiatives has been a dream of mine since I got involved in youth work 15 years ago. Doing it with a chosen team and with the support of <u>GCSP</u> is a dream come true. The focus on the next generation assures young professionals will be exposed to useful leadership practices early on in their careers generating impact from today onwards.

Project Objectives

- 1. To enhance the participants' ability to build trust and influence diverse stakeholders when working on challenging issues
- 2. To sustain participants to adopt leadership practices that quickly create and sustain collective direction, alignment, and commitment
- 3. To assist participants to adapt their communication and leadership style to the context in order to have more influence and impact
- 4. To put all learnings into practice immediately and get support from an international network of influential professionals
 - 5. To offer the opportunity to meet potential partners and to design and generate impact together
- 6. To engage with "the next generation of leaders" so that they become efficient actors in the European context



Methodology

The program's course will be based on nonformal education and activities involving intercultural dialogue and communication, using a highly interactive approach.

Participants' prior experiences as young leaders will be important and used in the development of the learning process.

Active teamwork, outdoor activities, and plenary discussions, as well as theoretical inputs, will characterize the program.

Self reflection time will be an important piece of the programme
